INSTRUCTIONS

- Candidates are directed to receive their Hall Tickets from the Principals of the concerned College before the commencement of the Examinations. In no circumstances the hall ticket will be sent to the candidates directly.
- Some candidates have submitted their online examination application without photos and their signatures. Such candidates should necessarily produce an Identification certificate with photo to the Chief Superintendent at the examination centre.
- In view of the COVID-19 pandemic, as per the Government of India "UGC-Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for conducting Examinations" dated 8th July, 2020 (Attached a copy); we request all the examination centers of YVU to adhere to following COVID-19 protocols in all respects during the UG examinations. **Make arrangements for seating as per the sample seating plan page No.6 of UGC guidelines.**
 - Ø Ensure soap and safe water is available at your college
 - Ø Make arrangements to measure body temperatures of students and staff regularly using non-contact thermometers
 - Ø Place hand sanitizers near the main entrance, in toilets, classrooms, and halls where possible
 - Ø Ensure adequate, clean and separate toilets or latrines for girls and boys
 - Ø Make sure that staff should wear a mask and hand gloves
 - Ø Clean and disinfect college buildings, classrooms and especially water and sanitation facilities at least once a day, particularly surfaces that are touched by many people (a railing, tables, door and window handles, etc.).
 - Ø Use sodium hypochlorite at 0.5% (equivalent 5000ppm) for disinfecting surfaces and 70% ethyl alcohol for disinfection of small items, and ensures appropriate equipment for cleaning staff.
 - Ø Increase airflow and ventilation where the climate allows (open windows, use air conditioning where available, etc.)
 - Ø Post signs Covid-19 precautions; encouraging good hand and respiratory hygiene practices

Ø Ensure trash is removed daily and disposed of safely
Ø Arrange Closed Circuit (CC) Cameras with UPS power backup in the examination rooms and submit the data to the Office of Controller of Examination University immediately after completion of examination through Observers.
